1. Competitors are reminded that the tyres must bear a **barcode** as per the relevant list published by the FIA. Furthermore competitors need to have the original **homologation document of the roll cage** in order to present it when required.
2. During the recce competitors must use the registered **recce vehicle**. Furthermore competitors are reminded that in the recce vehicle ONLY the crew is allowed. This applies for all stages, the Super Special Stage included.
3. Competitors are reminded that reconnaissance is not practice. The **maximum speed limit** of 80kph for the special stages and 50kph for the Super Special Stage must be strictly followed. An electronic tracking system will be used in order to monitor the speed in the stages.
4. Competitors are reminded that team personnel who will attend refuel zones must be wearing clothing which will provide adequate protection against fire.
5. Reference is made vis-a-vis the amendments to the Middle East Rally Championship Sporting Regulations following last Friday's WMSC meeting.

Kindly take note that the changes in the articles here below with immediate application are:

3.1 CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

3.1.1 For each Championship event run after 01.10.2020, points will be allocated according to Article 3.1.1 of the FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations:

- At the end of Leg 1 if the SS distance run was between 40 and 60% of the total rally SS distance.
Interpretation: As per the Provisional Unofficial Classification for Leg 1 including any time penalties.
- At the end of the rally.
Interpretation: it will be dealt with as a separate event and its classification will be based solely on the results achieved by the competitors throughout Leg 2 including any time penalties.

Important: Bonus points will NOT be allocated.

3.2 NUMBER OF RESULTS FOR THE FINAL CHAMPIONSHIPS CLASSIFICATION

3.2.1 The maximum number of results taken into account in the Championships will be equal to the number of points allocation made (rally or leg) less one, with a minimum of three.
